- A 2 hour meeting, either at my training headquarters of Rainwood Kennels, 377 Hutton Rd, Elkton MD or your home, depending upon location.
- A thorough assessment of your dog and the problem behaviors.
- Typed notes and specific recommendations will be emailed to you within 24 hours of meeting.
- A training packet with handouts detailing basic training skills.
- Ongoing email support.
- Further emailed articles and links for your education.
- A training program specifically tailored to help resolve the behavior issues of your dog.
- Humane, force free and positive training methods only.
- Educating YOU on how to effectively change your dogs` behavior.
- Keep in mind it takes time to unlearn undesired behaviors; owner commitment and follow through is necessary.

FEEES ACCORDING TO ISSUES: THREE LEVELS

- Basic Training Issues: (Running Away, Escaping, Digging, Excessive Mouthiness, Jumping Up, Pulling On Leash)
- Fear Aggression/No Bite History, On Leash Aggression or Separation Anxiety, Any form of Aggression/no bite history
- Fear Aggression/Bite History, Dog-Dog Aggression/Injuries
